National Congress of Italian Canadians – Edmonton District

Over the years the NCIC Edmonton has proudly founded the Appennini Dancers group, It has supported the founding of Il Congresso Italian Newspaper which was recently closed after 25 years of service to the community. We have donated a water fall in the Shaw Convention Centre to the City of Edmonton on its 75 birthday, a monument on the Legislative grounds to the Province for its 100th birthday. We sponsored and we manage an Italian senior citizens residence, Piazza Italia, since the early 80's and for approximately one year now we have been producing and televising a ½ an hour program on Shaw Cable—Channel 10 called "Panorama Italiano" which is shown every Sunday at 3:00PM.

Today most of our revenues come from the Servus Heritage Festival. The net proceeds from this function are invested back in the Italian community and the community at large in sponsoring any projects that are oriented towards strengthening our Canadian culture. Following is a list of the most recent projects we sponsor: A summer camp for our Italian-Canadian Seniors; a 5 year endowment fund for students of Italian language that attend the summer school in Vico Equense; Santa Maria Goretti Parish golf tournament; St. Matthews Italian pre-school; University of Alberta –Italian Program. The final issue of Il Congresso Newspaper; Italian Senior Citizen's Home-Piazza Italia Christmas Dinner; The Montréal trip of the Appennini Dancers; Italian Youth Association for the preparation of the Viva Italia Festival on Giovanni Caboto Park; Santa Maria Goretti Parish- sponsoring of young people to attend the World Youth Day; Donation to the Abruzzi Choir; Donation to the Lazio Club; sponsoring of the Panorama Italiano television show and donation to the Ladies of the Holy Rosary for their trip to southern Alberta; donation to the Canadian Volunteers for the International Development Society a local organization dedicated to providing medical assistance to poor people in Guatemala and in India and CELEBRATING ITALIAN FAMILIES OF EDMONTON SOCIETY (CIFES) for their yearly week-end celebrations of Italian culture.
